

Application Packet for Candidate Appointments for 2009-2010 Year

The Undergraduate Student Government Association (USGA) of Drexel University is holding appointments for all open positions for the 2009-2010 school year. The voting members of the USGA will elect these officers for the 2009-2010 academic year. Terms for these officers will begin at the first scheduled USGA meeting following the appointment and will last until the new officers for the following year are sworn in.

I. IMPORTANT DATES

1. The application deadline is **Wednesday January 20th, 2010 at 5 p.m.**

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE DEAN OF STUDENTS OFFICE OR BY EMAIL TO (sjm64@drexel.edu) BY 5 P.M. ON January 20th, 2010. The Dean of Students Office is located on the second floor of the Creese Student Center.

2. The appointment process is scheduled for **Monday, January 25th, 2010 at 7 p.m.** during our regular joint session.

II. ELIGIBILITY

All candidates for election to the USGA must meet the following requirements:

1. have at least a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
2. be a full-time undergraduate student.
3. not have a standing judicial sanction.

All applications will be reviewed by current USGA members prior to the joint session. Candidates are encouraged to write a speech outlining their qualifications and goals. This speech will be available to the current USGA representatives along with each candidate's application. Speeches are not to exceed 500 words. **Each candidate will have an opportunity to campaign for his/her appointment during the joint session. It is highly suggested that candidates attend the joint session that the appointment process is scheduled for.** USGA representatives will be given time to ask any questions relevant to the candidate's appointment (e.g., ideas, motivations, etc). As such, each candidate should come to the meeting prepared to explain why he/she should be appointed to a particular position.
